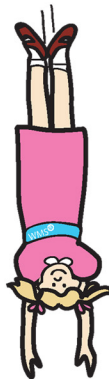


Writing Made Simple Positional Characters

Meet Harry Head, Sherry Shoulders, Barry Belly, and Terry Toes. The four animated "action-oriented" Writing Made Simple characters have several positions, all of which denote hand strokes necessary for writing letters and numbers. These positions have strong "visual components" and are specific to the parts of each letter and number. They are designed to assist children in construction and recognition of the alphanumeric characters as to piece placement. The following are images of the corresponding Writing Made Simple action-oriented caricatures and the specific "job" they perform.



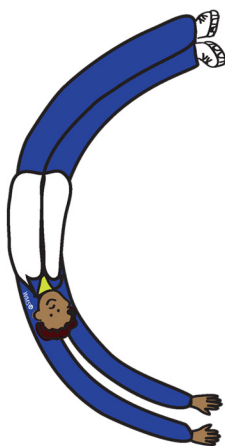
Harry Diver - Forms tall verticals and diagonals



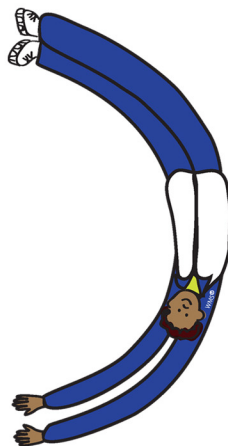
Sherry Diver - Forms short verticals and diagonals



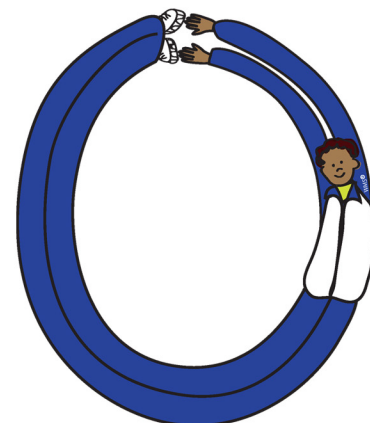
Sherry Horizontal - Forms short horizontal lines only



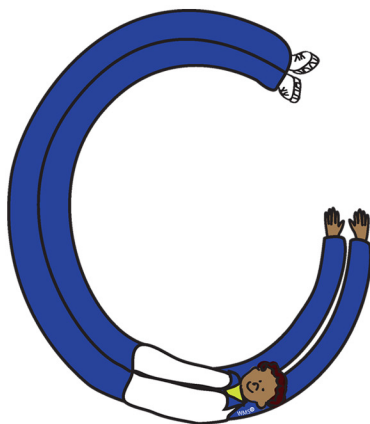
Barry "C" (Big Half Moon - Forward) - Forms the capital "C"



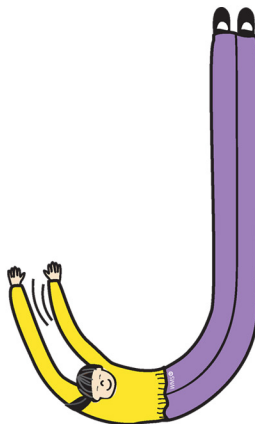
Barry "D" - Helps to form the capital "D" only



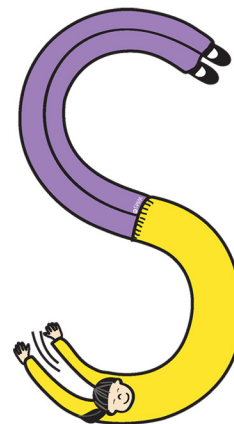
Barry "O" - Forms the capital "O"
